

Floodplain Management Ordinance

December 18, 2008

An ordinance to affirm an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Clark Township located in Mackinac County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

Clark Township ordains:

Section 1. Agency Designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator of Clark Township is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Clark Township under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. Clark Township assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the Township limits.

Section 2. Code Appendix Enforced.

Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within Clark Township.

Section 3. Designation of Regulated Flood Prone Hazard Areas.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) panel numbers of 25 and 50 and dated November 4, 1992 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3(1) of the Michigan Building Code.

Section 4. Repeals.

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Publication.

This ordinance shall be effective after legal publications and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
