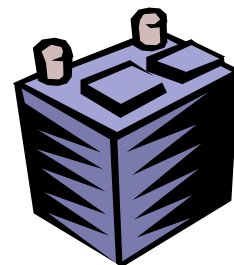

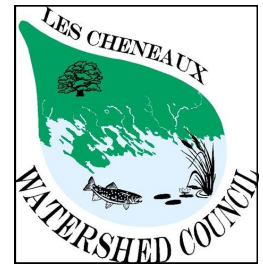
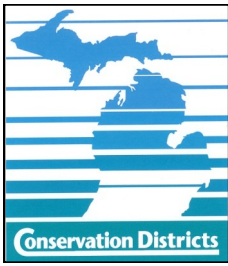

Household Hazardous Waste Collection

Saturday, July 26, 2008

The Les Cheneaux Watershed Council and Chippewa/East Mackinac Conservation District are sponsoring the second annual household hazardous waste collection day on Saturday, July 26, 2008, beginning at 9:00 a.m. and ending at 3:00 p.m. The event will be held in the parking lot of the Clark Township Building on Blindline Road.

Thanks to donations from the Watershed Council and the Les Cheneaux Community Foundation, we are able to host this much needed event. Due to limited resources, however, the event may end earlier than 3:00 p.m. The contractor for the project, Drug and Laboratory Disposal, Inc., weighs the hazardous materials as they are collected and charges the Watershed Project a per pound fee. When funds run out — the collection stops. To help fund this and future events, participants will be asked to make a donation — not required but certainly appreciated.

Start looking in your garage, basement, out buildings and even under the kitchen sink for items you would like to dispose of on July 26th. A list of items for disposal and items not taken is provided on the inside page of this flyer. Ammunitions, explosives and compressed gas cylinders can be taken with advance arrangements. For information or advance arrangements regarding these items, call the project office 484-3031.

We will not be accepting latex paint this year! Latex paint may be safely disposed of in the sanitary landfill **AFTER** it has been dried out. For small amounts, open lid and dry out or add sawdust or kitty litter. For larger amounts, paint the largest item you plan to take to the dump or spread the paint out on newspaper until it is dry. It can then go into the trash.
